



The Mohawk Race Parts and Accessories Pro-Stock Series starts this Saturday at Autodrome Drummond

Cornwall, Ont – The Mohawk Racing Parts and Accessories Pro-Stock Series gets underway this weekend, on Saturday, June 14 at Autodrome Drummond which will be the first of five races in that series.

It will be an historic night at Drummond on Saturday, because it is the first time ever that this series will make the haul to that speedway. The Pro-Stock category is making his debut in 2008 and already has some success. Jocelyn Roy is currently the man to beat with 3 wins to his credit. He will be a guy to watch when the Gauvreau, Ladouceur, Peters, Jackson, Aubin and others will be at the track on Saturday for the 35-lap feature event.

The series will continue at Cornwall Motor Speedway on Sunday, July 6 for a 50-lap race as it will be the first of two events at that speedway. Mohawk International Raceway will host the third race of the series on Saturday, July 19 the length of that race will be 35 laps. The action will continue at Autodrome Edelweiss on Friday, August 15 with a 50 lapper feature race and the series will conclude the same week-end at Cornwall on the Sunday with another 50-lap.

This series always attracts the best driver of all the tracks involved in that series. Again this year it should not be different as the officials expect a great field of cars for each race during the 5-race series.

PJ Peters was last year`s champion with 401 points, followed by Joey Ladouceur in second with 382 points, Gilles Godard with 347, Dave Bissonnette with 344 and Dion Oakes with 295 completed the top 5. Peters had won both events at Cornwall, Bissonnette was the winner at Edelweiss and Ladouceur claim the win at Frogtown.
