



## **A great schedule is building up at Edelweiss Speedway for the 2010 season**

The season will start with a bang on Friday, May 14 with the season opener; the modified category will be the headliner with a 50-lap Syracuse Qualifier feature race. The other regular classes will share the spotlight with the Semi-Pro, Mod-Lite and Mini-Stock seeing action on that night.

### **4 marquee events for the Modifieds**

Race fans that are looking for a racing fix on Canada Day will be pleased to hear that Edelweiss Speedway have secured the Mr.DIRTcar 358-Modified series that will be back at the speedway after a 3-year absence on Thursday, July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010. The best modified drivers will be in town to compete in this great show. We expect to have the biggest field of the year for this event.

Another show to add to your calendar will be the Canadian Super Challenge that will stop at the speedway on August 27 with a 100-lap feature race with more than \$20,000 in purse and more than 30 modified drivers will try to qualify for this show.

Along with these 2 events, the modifieds will have the spotlight on the Fundraiser nights scheduled for June 4th with the Canadian Cancer Society and July 30 for the Heart and Stroke Foundation. Each race will be 50-lap distance features and will also be Syracuse qualifiers.

### **Late Model, Sprint Car, Mini-Sprints & Mod-Lite**

The Ontario DIRT Late Model Series will be back on July 23<sup>rd</sup>, these spectacular cars gave a great show last year and drivers are anxious of getting back this year.

Sprint Car fans will be pleased to learn that the Speedway have secured 2 nights of Empire Super Sprint which is always a big attraction in the Outaouais region. They will visit the speedway on June 18 and August 13, which will be the night before the Quebec

Sprint Car Nationals run at Drummond, ESS promoters expect a great field of cars making to haul to Edelweiss in order to finish their preparation for the following night.

Along with the ESS, the Ontario series, Southern Ontario Sprint will return to the speedway after a long absence on Friday, July 9. This series uses the same rule package as ESS and have many great runners such as Rick Wilson.

The Lightning Mini-Sprint series also have a date scheduled on Friday, June 25 with a solid field of over 20 cars that is expected. This sprint are a smaller version of a normal sprint and runs with a motorcycle engine and are really fast, they gave an excellent show in their last visit in 2008, Mother Nature had won their night last year.

In the Mod-Lite category, Dean Pronovost was able to obtain a Winternationals date for East Bay, Florida in February 2011. Several drivers from other tracks will be at Edelweiss on June 18. Nearly 25 cars are expected.
