### **Friday, May 21 – Complete Program**

The regular categories will have a complete program this Friday with the modified class having its first Foundations BRL series race with \$1,000 in point's fund money given after the 4-race series has been completed. The Chartrand Yamaha 4-Wheeler series will also have its debut for the first of 9 shows throughout the year. Drivers that want to compete in the Super Enduro on Monday will have the chance to test their cars during a practice session at the end of the night.

### **Monday, May 24 – Super Enduro**

The Super Enduro is an always popular event with the fans of Edelweiss, many people have demonstrate interest in participating in this first enduro of the year with the second one scheduled at the end of the year. The 4 cylinders, 6 cylinders and 8 cylinders will have 50 laps of racing in each of the 3 categories. The winner of each race will receive \$500, second will get \$250 and third will leave Edelweiss with \$100 in his pockets; the purse is the same for the 3 classes in action during the afternoon. The first feature will start at 2pm and the pit gates will open at 10am with general admission opening at noon.
