



## **Stéphane Lafrance big winner at the Edelweiss Speedway!**

Cantley, PQ – Friday May 21, 2010 – Martin Bélanger – Edelweiss Speedway presented his second race program of the season with a complete race schedule plus the first events for the Chartrand Yamaha 4-wheeler series and a enduro practice for Monday`s event. NRJ 104.1 was the main sponsor of the night.

In the 30-lap Modified feature, Peter Mantha took the early lead over Stéphane Lafrance and Gage Morin, Lafrance was challenging Mantha for the lead and took it with an inside move in turn 4 on lap 3. Denis Gauvreau stopped in the frontstretch and this brought the first yellow on lap 9. Lafrance stayed first with Morin taking second spot. At the halfway point, Stéphane Lafrance was still the leader with Morin in second and Pierre Dagenais in third. Serge Lagacé flipped in turn 2 and the red flag came out on the 16<sup>th</sup> lap. On the green, Lafrance kept the lead with Dagenais taking second and McDonald also passed Morin for third. A good battle for fifth place between 3 cars as Pat Cashman brought the yellow on lap 23. Lafrance retained the lead over Dagenais and McDonald. Brian McDonald was now racing with Dagenais for second with two laps to go with Joel Doiron now in the mix. Lafrance led the final laps to win his first feature of the year over Dagenais, McDonald, Doiron and Luke Whitteker came in fifth.

A field of 17 cars took the green in the 15-lap Semi-Pro feature; Bruno Boivin took the lead when caution came out for Nico Leblanc on the first lap. Boivin kept the lead over Sébastien Bigras and Alain Proulx in third, caution came back out on lap 3 when Guy Regimbald spun out. Boivin and Proulx went into a good battle on the restart with Mark Trudeau joining them. Trudeau was really fast and used the inside lane to take lead over Boivin at the halfway point as caution came and slowed the race. Trudeau led another lap when caution came back out for Charles Galipeau who had a flat tire. Trudeau had a good start and led two more laps when Galipeau brought another yellow. On the following green, Trudeau was still ahead when Bruno Boivin had issues with his car and yellow came on the last lap. On the last restart, Alex Gagnon had a great start and took the lead in the backstretch over Trudeau and won his first feature of the year over Trudeau and Nico Leblanc completed the top 3.

Charles Legendre took where he led off from last week as he took the lead in the 12-lap Mod-Lite feature race. Legendre led the first five laps when he lost control in the second turn and caution was out on lap 5. Renaud the new leader took the lead but Dean

Pronovost was really fast and took the lead lap 6 and led the final laps to win his first feature of the year.

Jean-Marc Larose earned his first victory of the season in the 12-lap Mini-Stock feature. Jonathan Jans and Martin Bérard won the features in the 4-wheeler competition.

A great night of racing in which we had a special fundraiser for the Parkinson with the Brady family helping out, they were able to collect 383\$ during the evening.
