



Calm before the storm at Edelweiss Speedway!

Cantley, PQ – Tuesday, June 8, 2010 – Martin Bélanger –For the Edelweiss Speedway race fans, it will be the calm before the storm as the speedway will present a complete race program this Friday before having a series of 4 big shows in a row to end the month of June and start July. Some of these special shows will be important for several reasons.

Friday, June 11 – Photo and Autograph Night

La Pépinière du Golf presents a complete race program this Friday with the second race in the Fondation BRL Modified and Toitures Marcel Raymond 25-lap Semi-Pro series races. The Mini-Stock and Chartrand Yamaha 4-Wheeler series will also see some action as the drivers will take time during intermission to meet their fans on the track in front of the grandstand.

Friday, June 18 – Empire Super Sprints & Mod-Lite Winternationals Qualifier

If there is a program that you cannot miss at Edelweiss in 2010, it is this one! The Empire Super Sprints will be in town for their first of two visits; these cars can go up to 115-120mph around the 3/8mile Edelweiss track. Along with the ESS, the Mod-Lite class will have their most important event of the year with the Winternational Qualifier for a spot at the East Bay, Florida event, drivers from Montreal and Toronto area will be making the haul down. Dean Pronovost, promoter of the event, is expecting more than 30 cars. The Semi-Pro and Mini-Stock will also be on the racing card as the Modifieds will take a night off. It is a great time to take a walk around the pit area and see the cars as the pit will be at full capacity during this night.

Friday, June 25 – Lightning Mini-Sprints & EDG Equipments Modified Series

The Lightning Mini-Sprints Immovex will make their lone stop at Edelweiss on that Friday evening. These small vehicles are a smaller scale version of an ESS sprint and runs with a motorcycle engine. This series is pretty solid with over 30 registered cars in their Eastern Quebec championship. Around 20 drivers are expected to show up at Edelweiss for the 20-lap feature event. The first of four races in the EDG Equipment Modified Series between Brockville and Edelweiss will also be on the racing card with a regular 30-lap race. The Mod-Lite and Chartrand Yamaha 4-Wheeler race will also be racing with the Mini-Stock having a night off. A kid's tire race will be held during intermission time.

Thursday, July, 1 – MrDIRTcar 358-Modified Series – 100 laps

The Edelweiss headline class will have their own big event with the MrDIRTcar 358-Modified series making a stop at Edelweiss. A 100-lap feature race with more than \$20,000 in purse money with the winner's share being at \$4,000. Big names from Quebec, Ontario and Northern United-States will be in the pits to try and win this event and collect valuable points toward the MrDIRTcar trail. A complete race program is also on hand on Gauvreau Top-Soil Night. Time Trials will be start at 5:30pm and qualifying is scheduled to start at 6pm, we suggest that you arrive early at the track.

Friday, July 9 – Southern Ontario Sprints

Sprint car fans will be pleased to hear that they will have the chance to see another group called the Southern Ontario Sprints in action. These cars are the same type of cars as the ESS with different drivers. SOS promoter is very excited and they expect to send a solid field of sprinters for this show. A complete show plus Chartrand Yamaha 4-wheelers and the modifieds are off.
