



A great night of racing is planned for Friday June 18 at Edelweiss Speedway!!

Cantley, QC – Monday, June 14, 2010 – Martin Bélanger – Edelweiss Speedway will be host of one of the most exciting program of the year this Friday, June 18th with the Empire Super Sprints making their first stop of the season along with the biggest event of the year for the Mod-Lites with the Winternationals Qualifier. The Semi-Pro and Mini-Stock will also see some action on Tag Radio X Night.

A solid field of sprint cars is expected for this Friday's 25-lap event paying \$2,000 to the winner. Chuck Hebing currently leads the way in the overall point's championship only 10 points ahead of Steve Poirier and veteran driver Lance Yonge. Justin Barger and Jessica Zemken complete the top 5. Other drivers expected to be in the pits are Michael Parent, Alain Bergeron, Normand Beaudreault and local favourites Sylvain Erickson and Erin Joyce will represent the Quebec province. Brian McDonald a strong runner at Edelweiss will also be present. American drivers Dan Kaszubinski, Jeff Cook and Mike Stelter will compete for the win. Other well known names at Edelweiss, such as Paul Pekkonen, Tyler Rand and Chris Jones could join the field.

The Mod-Lite category will compete in their biggest event of the year as nearly 30 drivers are expected to haul down to the 3/8 mile track located in the Gatineau Mountains. Series promoter Dean Pronovost have worked hard in getting a good field built and should be one of the highlights of the year with that much cars on the track. Paul Klager, Dan Kviring, Josh and Ray Sliter should lead the pack from the Toronto Area and will compete against local stars such as Pronovost, Richard Renaud, Charles Legendre and company. A 25-lap feature race is on the schedule and the winner will get a spot at the Winternationals at East Bay Florida in February 2011.

Along with the Empire Super Sprints and Mod-Lite, the always exciting Semi-Pro will have a regular 15-lap race event and the Mini-Stock will be on the racing card with a 12-lap feature.

The pit gates will open at a special time in order to accommodate the Sprint cars and Mod-Lite, the doors will open at 4pm. General Admission will open at 6:15pm. Admission prices will be 20\$ for adults, 16\$ for Students and seniors and free for kids 12 years old and under in General Admission. The cost will be 30\$ for adults and a flat rate of 5\$ for children that are 12 years old and under.
