



Mathieu Bourgouin wins the Immovex Lightning Mini-Sprints Feature race at Edelweiss Speedway

Cantley, PQ – Friday June 25, 2010 – Martin Bélanger – A big night of racing for the fans of Edelweiss Speedway with the Immovex Lightning Mini-Sprints Series along with the first series race of the EDG Equipment for modifieds, the Semi-Pro, Mod-Lite and Chartrand Yamaha 4-Wheeler races were also on the schedule on Coors Light night.

In the 20-lap Immovex Lightning Mini-Sprints, a strong field of 23 cars took the green with Stéphane St-Laurent taking the early lead with Yves Girard in second. Girard passed St-Laurent using the outside lane on the second lap but St-Laurent charges back with the 2 drivers exchanging the lead with 6 laps down as the yellow flag is thrown out of the same lap. Girard stayed first with Simon Couture as a dancing partner. Couture was very strong using the outside lane, took the lead on lap 8. The red flag was out at halfway point for David Ferland who rolled over in the second corner. Couture kept first followed by Bourgouin. The young 18 year old driver passed Couture for the lead on the 15th lap and led the remainder of the feature to win in front of Couture and Eric Sundborg completed the top 3.

Luke Whittaker took the lead in the 30-lap Modified feature race with Pierre Dagenais and Chris King taking second and third, Stéphane Lafrance got together with King and the yellow came out on the second lap. Whittaker still in front with Dagenais following him closely when John Mulder slows the field down after stopping in the front stretch on lap 3, Whittaker has good restart with Laurent Ladouceur passing Dagenais for second. The yellow flag was back out when Ryan Foley and Mulder got together in turn 3. On the restart, Whittaker resisted to the challenge as yellow was back out. The red flag was given on lap 10 for incidents involving drivers Laurent Ladouceur and Pierre Dagenais, the driver of car #124 refused the race directors indications and for security reasons for other drivers the race was stopped and the remainder of the feature will be run on Friday, July 16.

The 15-lap Semi-Pro feature was interrupted with 7 laps completed when Michel Asselin had a severe accident in the front stretch and because of the mandatory curfew, the 8 remaining laps will be completed at the start of next Thursday, program.

Dean Pronovost took the lead in the 12-lap Mod-Lite Feature followed by Charles Legendre and outsider Réjean Lemieux. Pronovost in first with Legendre right on his tail for second with 5 laps down, Legendre passed Pronovost 2 laps later and took the lead.

Mathieu Robinson brought the caution with only 2 laps to go. Legendre has a good restart and leads the final laps to win his third feature of the year in front of Pronovost and Lemieux.

The Edelweiss headline class will have their own big event with the MrDIRTcar 358-Modified series making a stop at Edelweiss. A 100-lap feature race with more than \$20,000 in purse money with the winner's share being at \$4,000. Big names from Quebec, Ontario and Northern United-States will be in the pits to try and win this event and collect valuable points toward the MrDIRTcar trail. A complete race program is also on hand on Gauvreau Top-Soil Night. Time Trials will be start at 5:30pm and qualifying is scheduled to start at 6pm, we suggest that you arrive early at the track.
