The best field of modifieds is expected for this spectacular event. Many big names in the 358-modified ranks have shown interest in participating in the Thursday night race. We advise fans to arrive early as the time trials are scheduled for 5:30pm with the first heat starting at 6pm. Pit gates will open at 2pm and general admission at 4pm. The cost will be 20\$ for adults, 16\$ for seniors and students and kids 12 years old and under will get in free in general admission. People that want to go into the pits will have to disburse 30\$ and kids 12 years old and under will have a flat rate of 5\$.
