



Edelweiss Speedway cancels his July 9th events due to inclement weather conditions

Cantley, PQ – Friday, July 9, 2010 – Mother Nature won her first event of the year at Edelweiss Speedway with rain and thunderstorms forcing the speedway's official to cancel tonight's race program that included the first visit of the Southern Ontario Sprints along with Semi-Pro, Mini-Stock and Mod-Lite categories.

The action will continue next week with the completion of the June 25th 30-lap modified feature with only 10 laps completed along with a complete race program that consists of the 3rd series race of the Fondations BRL Modified Series and also the Toitures Marcel Raymond Semi-Pro Series with a 25-lap event. The Mod-Lite and Mini-Stock will also be on the racing card along with a wet track enduro event at the end of the evening.

Admission price will be 12\$ for adults, 8\$ for Students and seniors and Kids 12 years old and under will be admitted for free. Pit gate admission will be 20\$ with a fixed fee of 5\$ for the children that are 12 years old or less. Gates will open at 6pm for the pits and 6:30pm for general admission.
