



The 3rd edition of the Simone 50 this Friday at Edelweiss Speedway!

Cantley, PQ – Tuesday, July 27, 2010 – Martin Bélanger – Edelweiss Speedway will present a great show next Friday, July 30th with the 3rd edition of the Simone 50 part of the Heart and Stroke Foundation Fundraiser event. The modified category will have the spotlight with a 50-lap Syracuse Qualifier feature race plus a special 35-lap race event for the Semi-Pro and a 15-lap finale for the Mod-Lite class.

A good field of modified drivers is expected for this race, with \$2,000 to win on the line; this should attract a few drivers that only do a few appearances at Edelweiss during the season. With a spot for Syracuse in October to winner, this makes this 50-lap finale even more attractive.

The Semi-Pro will share the night with several cars from other tracks making the haul to Edelweiss for the 35-lap with \$500 going to the winner with \$2,000 in purse money.

Edelweiss Speedway will collect funds in 3 different ways over the night, the first one is 1\$ of per entry will go to the society. The Speedway is committed to equal each entry. It will be a total of 2\$ for each race fan that pays admission that will go to the Foundation.

Fans will be able to buy tickets for 5\$ and will have a chance to win several prizes. A corporate suite for 8 persons for the Friday, August 13th Empire Super Sprints show, a value of \$275, a second corporate suite will be up for grabs for the same night with a value of 275\$. A third one will be given out for the Canadian Super Challenge show on Friday, August 27, a value of \$275. The fourth and fifth prizes will be 4 tickets with pit access for any show during the year, a value of up to \$120 each. A total value of over \$1,000 will be given out in prizes.

A third option will be the purchase of the Speedway promotional T-Shirt at \$10, the track will give 2\$ per t-shirt sold on that night and with every purchase, a ticket will be given out for the draw prizes.
