



Eric Gauvreau wins his second feature of the season at Edelweiss Speedway!

Cantley, PQ – Friday May 22, 2009 – Martin Bélanger – Great weather and a good car count greeted the fans on Energie 104.1 night, a complete race program was on the program along with a 25-lap feature race for the Semi-Pro counting for the first race of the Toitures Marcel Raymond mini-series. The 4-wheelers were also in action.

A field of 16 cars took the green flag in the 30-lap modified feature. Dan Jalbert took the early lead but an accident occurred in the back and yellow came out on the first lap. Jalbert stayed in front with Ryan Poole second and Eric Gauvreau in third. A good battle was going on for second between Poole, Gauvreau and Kyle Dingwall when caution came back on the field on the tenth lap. On the restart, Eric Gauvreau took the lead over Jalbert and Dingwall is on the back bumper of Jalbert at the halfway point. Dagenais who started at the back after his caution was now back in the top 5 after a great move on Joel Doiron. Gauvreau built himself a comfortable lead with only 5 laps to go. Gauvreau led the final laps to win his second feature of the season overt Jalbert, Dingwall, Dagenais and Doiron. Gauvreau had perfect night winning his heat race and the new bonus Coffrage 20-20 bounty valued at 350\$. Kyle Dingwall won the other qualifier.

Bruno Boivin took the early lead in the 25-lap Semi-Pro Feature, Alex Gagnon and Richard Brady are respectively second and third, the yellow came out on the fifth lap when an accident occurred in the second turn. Boivin stays first with Benoit Dubois that tries to pass Gagnon for second when he has issue with his car and yellow is back out on the tenth lap. Boivin in the lead with Mark Trudeau now third after a great move when a multi-car accident occurred on the following lap and the race was slowed again. Boivin had a strong start with Serge Lagacé and Alex Gagnon doing battle for third as Mark Trudeau used the inside lane to pass Boivin for the lead on lap 16. The yellow comes 2 laps later for Charles Galipeau that stopped in the middle of the track. Trudeau is followed closely by Boivin on the green when Dubois and Steve Gagné got tangled in turn 4 and yellow is out with 5 to go. Trudeau led the final laps to win the feature over Boivin and Lagacé completes the podium. Trudeau also won the second heat; Nico Leblanc and Serge Lagacé won the others.

Dean Pronovost and Richard Renaud got into a good battle early on as Pronovost took the lead for good and let the feature to win his second feature of the season in the Mod-Lite category over Justin Lalancette and Renaud completed the podium. Renaud had won the heat race.

In the 12-lap 4-cylinders feature, a great battle occurred for the lead between Alexandre Pilon, Gabriel Mercier, Martin Lagacé and Jean-Marc Larose, these drivers swapped the lead and it is finally Pilon that his first feature of the season over Gabriel Mercier and Martin Lagacé. Mercier won the heat.

Jonathan Jans and Yan Pétrin won the features in the 4-wheeler races.

Another great night of racing with a lot of action in each class. An important night next week with a fundraiser for the Canadian Cancer Society with the second edition of the Carole Legault 50 with a 50-lap modified feature with a Syracuse Qualifier.
