



## **Bad weather forces Edelweiss Speedway to cancel July 24<sup>th</sup> race events**

Cantley, PQ – Friday July 24, 2009 – Martin Bélanger – Bad weather conditions during the day along with a high chance of rainfalls over Friday night, forced the promoter of Edelweiss Speedway to cancel the July 24 race program.

Edelweiss had plan to received the Lightning Mini-Sprints Series for their annual trip at the speedway along with a complete race program and a wet track enduro at the end of the night but the rain precipitations changed all the plans.

The biggest race program of the season is next Friday on Toitures Marcel Raymond night with the Lucas Oil Canadian DIRT Challenge Series in town. The best modified drivers of Quebec, Ontario and Northern United-States will be at Edelweiss to compete in a 100-lap event. Last year, 39 drivers showed up and it should be about the same for 2009. Time trials will start the evening at 6:45pm

Also on the schedule, a regional points race for the TUSA series for Mod-Lite, more than 20 drivers have already confirmed their presence at the speedway for this 25-lap feature race. The competitors will come from the Toronto area and also from Delaware, USA. The 4-cylinder category will also see some action. General admission will be 20\$ for adults, 16\$ for students and seniors and free for kids 12 years old and under. Pit admission price will be 30\$.
