



The Canadian Cancer Society Fundraiser Night is postponed to June 5th due to bad weather conditions

The 4-wheelers will be back in action for a second week in a row. The North-American 4-cylinder class will be postponed to a later date in June. General admission will be 17\$ for adults, 13\$ for students and seniors, kids 12 years and under get in for free. The pit admission price will be 27\$ for people 13 years and up and 5\$ for kids 12 and under.
