

The Canadian Super Challenge becomes reality for 2010 !

With the announcement of the Canadian DIRT Challenge not coming back in 2010, a few track owner decided to create a new series called the Canadian Super Challenge. This new championship will include Autodrome Granby, Drummond, Edelweiss and also Brockville Speedway.

Autodrome Granby will be the host of the first race on Friday, July 23rd with Autodrome Drummond being next the following night. After more than a month off, the battle will continue at Autodrome Edelweiss on Friday, August 27 with the champion being crowned on the next night at the Brockville Speedway on Saturday, August 28. Each race will be 100-lap in distance with a minimum of 30 cars that will take the green.

Large amount of money on the line

More than \$20,000 in purse will be given at each race with the winner receiving \$3,000 and each qualified drivers will leave the track with at least \$350 in his pockets.

A point's fund of \$8,000 will also be divided between the 10 best drivers at the of the 4-race series. The champion will be \$2,500 richer, second \$1,500, third \$1,000, 4th \$750, 5th \$600, 6th \$500, 7th \$400 and positions 8 to 10, will receive \$250.

With potential sponsors joining the series, several new amounts and prizes will be added to an already high paying series of \$90,000!

Règlements et informations

Les promoteurs se sont entendus sur une liste de règlements et informations pertinentes. En voici la liste :

- DIRTcar rules will be in effect with the right rear tire must be a HARD and mandatory at each track, the weight will be at a minimum of 2,400 lbs at each event.
- Each race will be a Syracuse Qualifier.
- Heat Winner receives 100\$ as if a driver fails to qualify he will receive \$100.
- The DIRTcar championship point system will be in effect, I.E: 100, 95, 90...
- Points will be given in the top 5 in the heats (10, 8, 6, 4, 2)
- The champion will be crowned at the end of the last race after calculations of points
- No guaranteed starter.
- No rain date will be given.

- Time-Trials will be 30 minutes before the heats.
- The field of cars for the feature will be determined by the time trials, heats and consolations.
- The best 12 in the heats will have a draw to determine the top 12 starting positions in the feature.
- Local officials will be responsible to manage the series when it visits their speedway.
- To help driver participation, 50 points will give at each race that the driver will race in. For example, if Pierre Dagenais competes in the 4 races, he will get 200 extra points in the local point`s fund at Edelweiss, Drummond, Granby and Brockville.

This new series will enable drivers to race of 4 different tracks with the chance of racing against the best competitors of Quebec and Ontario with having the opportunity to be crowned the best driver of the battle of the provinces.
